

5 Ideas for Continuing Learning on a Snow Day

1

Read. Read. Read.

Send home #snowday book packs (Student Choice of course!) or do a video read-aloud of a favorite book & post on Youtube or your Class Page for your students!

2

Make a Rube Goldberg.

Share a video of a Rube Goldberg contraption with students & encourage them to create their own at home. Students will have a blast & learn engineering principles.

3

Play, Build & Create.

When Ss get outside & play, they can learn great lessons from building & creating! Make a snowman. Build a snow fort or igloo. Just enjoy the learning that comes along w/ play.

4

Make a Meal or Snack.

Provide simple recipes for meals/snacks that Ss can make at home. Ss can learn fractions or steps in a procedure. Ss can make their own creations & write the recipe themselves.

5

Extend 20% Time or Genius Hour.

Give Ss the opportunity to pursue their passions. Students can use Google Drive to engage in ventures that are meaningful and relevant to their own learning.
